

## The Farm Tech Challenge

### Terms & Conditions

1. There is no limit to the number of submissions from any one school.
2. The Challenge is open to all UK students aged 11-14 years.
3. Submissions can be made by individuals or groups of up to five students.
4. The deadline for submitting an entry to the Challenge is **23:59** hours on **Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2017**.
5. Syngenta cannot take responsibility for submissions which are not received or which are received after the closing date due to technical failure or for any other reason.
6. Prize winners will be notified by May 2017. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. There shall be no cash substitute or alternative prize offered.
8. The prize is non-transferable.
9. Incomplete submission forms will be deemed invalid.
10. A valid submission should include: a video (lasting no more than three minutes); a written submission (of no more than 1500 words) and a completed registration form.
11. Schools must ensure consistency of file labelling and form filling to ensure that organisers and the judges can properly assess each submission.
12. In the event that any individual(s) appearing in the submission (in whatever format) is a minor, the school shall obtain necessary consent from the minor's parent or legal guardian. It is the schools' responsibility to ensure that relevant safeguarding policies are met.
13. Each school / entrant agrees that Syngenta shall not be liable for any claims, costs, liabilities, damages, expenses and losses arising out of entering the Challenge.
14. The school should have obtained necessary permissions for the inclusion of any third party intellectual property within the submission.
15. Syngenta or any Farm Tech Challenge partner may use your submission for promotional purposes (for example, placing it on their website, poster, leaflet or other advertising media).
16. Shortlisted entries may be featured in various promotions, such as social media.
17. You confirm that your submission is original; that you own and have the right to license to Syngenta the copyright and other intellectual property rights in the submission for the purposes referred to in these Terms and Conditions. You will retain ownership of copyright of your submission but you give Syngenta (and any third party authorised by Syngenta) your irrevocable permission to use, reproduce, publish, display, transmit, copy, amend, store, sell and sub-licence your submission worldwide for such promotional purposes and for the purposes of the Challenge.
18. Prizes are only available for five people in the winning teams.
19. Schools will be responsible for their students travel arrangements and costs relating to the 1<sup>st</sup> prize awarded of a "Farm Tech Experience", for example a visit to Jealott's Hill, University Department or the Industry Partner premises.
20. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law and the Parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
